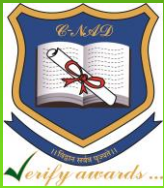

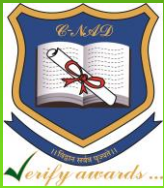


Get ready for Digital Academic Certificates



First, there was the Depository for securities, which significantly reduced fake share certificates.

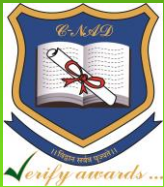
Now, it is time for a Depository for another set of Certificates – from Universities and Boards of Education.

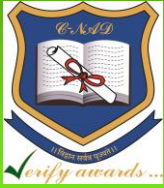
- More than 650 Universities and 50 Boards in India.

 - Demat of old awards initiated through awardee
 - Verification – Online, Bulk
 - Transcripts – Paper, Electronic
 - Value Added Services

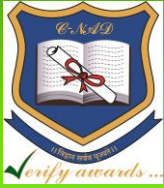


National Academic Depository-Demat

 - Transfer Certificates

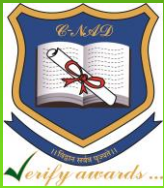




Existing shortcomings & concerns

- Cumbersome and time consuming verification procedure
- Difficulty in obtaining duplicates
- Difficulty in obtaining transcripts
- Fake / forged awards
- Non-registered institutions and courses

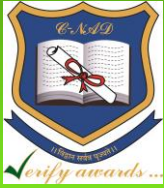

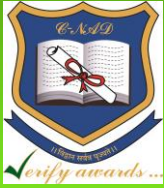
- Recruiting organizations will verify genuineness of awards submitted

 - All the results would be linked to the login ID / student code
 - Same award details cannot be linked to more than one login / student code
- Foreign institutions

 - Verification access through Online/upload
 - Payments through payment gateways

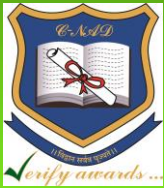
